



Travel Subsidy Reimbursement Claim Eligibility

As stated in ISC's event invitation:

“ISC will sponsor First Nations Chiefs (or a proxy) and a plus one. Sponsorship is also extended to Indigenous Representative Organization leadership, Executive Directors of Tribal Councils, and Health Directors.”

This means eligibility for the Travel Subsidy Reimbursement is for 3 possible delegates for each Ontario First Nation (outlined below), 1 delegate from an Indigenous Representative Organization (typically the Executive Director), and 1 delegate from a Tribal Council (typically the Executive Director).

The 3 possible sponsored delegates for each Ontario First Nation are:

1. First Nations Chief (or Proxy)
2. Chief's Plus One (such as a Councillor, Band Administrator, Program Manager, etc.)
3. Health Director

PLEASE NOTE: *First Nations may have more than the 3 possible delegates attend the Joint Gathering, at the First Nation's expense.*

As well, Indigenous Representative Organizations and Tribal Councils may have more than 1 delegate attend the Joint Gathering, at the Organization or Tribal Council's expense.

REMINDER: Reimbursements are made to the First Nation or Organization, NOT to individual attendees.
